3 Tuition Payment Options:

Each option is calculated depending on the total number of classes per week. Tuition is based on 36 weeks of instruction. While we periodically break throughout the year, payment for tuition is expected on a regular basis.

- 1. Monthly Tuition Payments:** 9 equal payments for September through May. Tuition is due by the 1st of each month. You will be billed on-line.
- 2. Semester Tuition Payments:** 1 payment per semester includes a \$5 discount per class.
 - 1st Semester: (September 11, 2017 - February 2, 2018) Due week of September 11, 2017
 - 2nd Semester: (February 5, 2018 - June 16, 2018) Due week of February 5, 2018
- 3. Yearly Tuition Payment:** 1 payment for the dance year includes a \$10 discount per class.

Payment Information:

1. Accepted methods of payment: Cash * Check * Visa * MasterCard * Discover* American Express*
Your credit card will be charged on the 1st of the month September-May if you choose to pay monthly. You can set up credit card payment in the parent portal from our website www.isabelledancetime.com.
2. Payments are due on the **1st of the month** (except September then it is due the week of the September 11, 2017) and may be made online if paying by credit card. If you are paying by check or cash you can pay at the office, or by mail.
3. When making a payment by check, please include the dancer's first and last name in the memo of your check, so we may credit the proper account.
4. Returned check fee \$25.00.
5. Overdue Balances: A statement will be mailed and/or emailed for amount due with late charges assessed. A late fee of \$10 monthly and \$50 by semester, will be applied to any unpaid tuition past due 10 days.
6. If for any reason you decide to discontinue your classes, you will be responsible for any balance due.
7. We do not send out monthly bills.
8. You will automatically be changed to monthly payments if you do not pay entire semester tuition in September and February. See Isabelle for special payment arrangements.

Withdrawals:

1. Classes start September 11,2017 and end after the June 16,2018 performance. While students are not obligated to remain for the entire year, when a student is enrolled it is for the entire year.
2. Please inform the instructor of any classes dropped or added. Two week notice is required for any withdraws.
3. ***Tuition, Registration, Performance and Costume payments are Nonrefundable, Nontransferable, Nonadjustable.***
4. If a very young student is not ready to participate in a class after several visits, a refund of tuition will be given.
5. When student sustains an injury or has a lengthy illness that does not permit them to participate over an extended period of time a credit or refund will be issued. Illness or injury must be verified by your doctor.
6. Credit will not be given for missed classes due to illness, snow days, or personal commitments. You are welcome to make-up any class missed.
7. Dancers are encouraged to complete a makeup class(es) in the event of an absence.

Referral Discount:

Refer a friend and you both get a \$25.00 discount on your tuition. New student must register for a full Semester.

Work Study Discounts:

Work study discounts will have to be figured out individually, see Isabelle.

Registration Charges:

An annual enrollment fee of \$20.00 per student or \$30.00 per family is collected at the time of registration. The enrollment fee is ***Nonrefundable, Nontransferable, Nonadjustable.***

Performance Charges:

Performance Fees are \$40 per student or \$60 per family. Performance fee is due November 1, 2017. All students are automatically pre-registered for the optional June 16, 2018, Dance Performance.

2. If the students listed above do not wish to participate in the performance, please notify the studio no later than January 1, 2018, by contacting the office.

3. If we are not notified, full payment of your costume or costumes order is required.

Includes free admission to our annual performance June 16, 2018.

The Performance Fee is ***Nonrefundable, Nontransferable, Nonadjustable.***

Costumes Charges:

Will be determined in January and invoices will be sent out mid February 2018.

Costume Fee will be due in mid-March.

Isabelle's Dance Time Policies and Procedures 2017-2018

Attendance:

All students are expected to arrive on time for class in the proper attire and his or her own, we ask that a parent help with this responsibility. If a student is ill he or she is expected to stay home. If a student is injured and would like to observe, he or she may do so. If a student is absent there will be no adjustment of tuition.

Parents must be ready to pick up their children as soon as possible after class has adjourned. Isabelle's Dance Time is not liable or responsible for watching your child. Please do not leave a sibling in the waiting room while the other sibling dances unless a parent plans to stay and observe as well.

NEWS / ANNOUNCEMENTS:

There is a bulletin board located in the studio lobby. Monthly Newsletters, notice of special events, schedule changes, etc., will be posted there for your reference. The Monthly Newsletters will be e-mailed out and are available on printed form in the studio lobby.

DANCE STUDIO AND LOBBY AREA:

*Only students, teachers and assistants are allowed in the studio rooms during class time.

*No gum, food, or drinks are permitted in the studio rooms. Water bottles are allowed.

*The waiting area is for the convenience of our students and their families. Be sure to respect others and the classes in session.

Dress Code:

Our dress code was created to promote the proper attitude and respect for all dance disciplines. No street clothes or footwear will be permitted. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated and allows our staff to give their undivided attention to the needs of all our students. Dance shoes, tights, leotards and accessories are available for purchase at the studio or Empire Dance Shop and on-line Discount Dance Supply.

The following guidelines apply to all dancers:

*HAIR must be securely tied back in a ponytail, braid, or bun.

*DO NOT WEAR YOUR DANCE SHOES OUTSIDE. You will not only ruin your shoes, but our dance floors could be damaged as well.

*NO jewelry is to be worn in class. Not only is it a distraction, it dangerous and items can be lost. Post/Stud earrings are acceptable.

*Please label all shoes and other related dance items with your dancer's name so lost items may be returned. Isabelle's Dance Time is not responsible for lost items.

*PLEASE COME TO CLASS READY TO DANCE, with proper cover-ups on when entering and exiting

Ballet/Pointe:

Any colored leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet/pointe shoes must be worn.

Hair must be secured in a bun or ponytail at all times. Short hair must be pulled away from the face and neck. A ballet sweater and/or skirt may be worn.

Jazz:

Leotard, jazz pants or dance shorts, and fitted top. Legs must be covered. Tights are strongly encouraged. Black jazz shoes.

Contemporary:

Leotard, jazz pants or dance shorts, and fitted top. Legs must be covered. Convertible tights are strongly encouraged.

As the parent/legal guardian of _____, I agree to hold harmless from any and all liability the school, its officers, employees both in their professional capacity and personally for all injury or illness resulting from or in any way connected with his/her participation in the classes, activities or special events at the school. I understand that it is the school's policy that while under the supervision of the school no child is allowed to leave the building without a parent/legal guardian or the written permission of a parent/legal guardian and that the parent/legal guardian assumes full responsibility for the actions and behavior of the child. I understand that appropriate physical contact is required during the instruction of dance, and I give permission for instructors to make appropriate physical contact with me or my child for such instruction. I/legal guardians give their permission to the school to use photos and or video of their child without payment in connection with school publications, advertising, tv and news coverage. As the legal parent or guardian, I release and hold harmless Isabelle's Dance Time, its owners and operators from any and all liability, claims, demands, and causes of action whatsoever, arising out of or related to any loss, damage, or injury, including death, that may be sustained by the participant while in or upon the premises or any premises under the control and supervision of Isabelle's Dance Time its owners and operators or in route to or from any of said premises.
